NOTIFICATION

G. O. (P) No. 2/2000/CAD. Dated, Thiruvananthapuram, 3rd January 2000.

S. R. O. No. 20/2000.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Service Act, 1968 (19 of 1968), and in supersession of all the existing rules and orders on the subject, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following Special Rules for the Kerala Archaeological Subordinate Service, namely:—

RULES

1. *Short Title and Commencement.*—(1) These rules may be called the Kerala Archaeological Subordinate Service Rules, 2000.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. *Constitution.*—The service shall consist of the following categories of officers, namely:—

2. Filed Assistant (Malabar Survey)

4. Preservation Assistant

7. Research Assistant (Numismatics)

3. *Appointing Authority.*—The appointing authority of the various categories shall be the Director of Archaeology.

4. *Method of appointment.*—Appointment to the various categories specified in column (1) of the table below, shall be made by the method of appointment specified against each in column (2) thereof, namely:—

(i) Appointment by transfer from the Ministerial wing and from the Last Grade Service of the Department of Archaeology in the ratio of 1:1.

Note.— Appointment shall be made on the basis of the length of continuous service in the respective category.

Note:—(i) Wherever promotions/appointment by transfer are indicated it shall be made on the basis of length of continuous service in the respective feeder categories.

(ii) (a) Inservice training is compulsory to the posts under these rules as may be prescribed from time to time by Government.
(b) “Nothing contained in this rule shall adversely affect the appointments made prior to the commencement of these rules as per the rules and orders then in force”.

5. *Qualification regarding age.*—No person shall be eligible for appointment by direct recruitment if, he has not completed 18 years of age or has completed 35 years of age, on the 1st day of January of the year in which applications for appointments are invited with usual relaxation of upper age limit to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes.

6. *Other Qualifications.*—No person shall be eligible for appointment to the category specified in column (1) of the Table below by the method of appointment specified in column (2) unless he posses the qualifications specified in the corresponding entries in column (3) thereof:—

7. *Reservation of appointments:*

The Rules for reservation of appointments (General Rules 14 to 17) in the Kerala State and Subordinate Services Rules, 1958 shall apply to appointments by direct recruitment.

8. *Probation:*

Every person appointed to any category shall, from the date on which he joins duty be on probation—

- (a) if appointed by direct recruitment for a total period of two years on duty with in a continuous period of three years; and
- (b) if appointed by promotion or by transfer for a total period of one year on duty, with in a continuous period of two years.

9. *Training:*

A person appointed by direct recruitment or by transfer to any category of the service shall undergo such training, as may be prescribed, from time to time.

10. *Tests:*

Every person appointed to category 2 to 12 and 15 to 17 shall, with in the period of probation, pass either the Account Test for Executive Officer or the Account Test (Lower), if he has not already passed the same.

Explanatory Note

(This is not part of Notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The Special Rules for the Kerala Archaeological Subordinate Service were issued in G.O. (P) No. 158/74/H.Edn. dated 28th October 1974 and were subsequently amended as per G.O. (P) 209/79/H.Edn. dated 18th October 1979 and G.O.(P) 21/80/H.Edn. dated 13th February 1980. Since then, many posts with identical scales of pay have been newly created in the Department. For some posts, the qualifications, method of appointment etc. prescribed have to be modified. It is, therefore, necessary that revised special rules have to be issued in order to incorporate herein the amendments issued, from time to time, fixing qualifications and method of appointment to the newly created posts and also to revise the qualifications and method of appointment.

This notification is intended to achieve the above object.
