NOTIFICATION

S. R/O. No. 19/2000.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Service Act, 1968 (19 of 1968) and in supersession of all the existing rules and orders on the subject, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following Special Rules for the Kerala Archaeological Service, namely:—

RULES

I. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) These rules may be called the Special Rules for the Kerala Archaeological Service, 2000.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

II. *Constitution.*—The service shall consist of the following categories of officers namely:—

Category:

1. Director of Archaeology
2. Conservation Officer
3. Superintending Archaeologist
4. Epigraphist
5. Archaeological Chemist
6. Publication Officer
7. Documentation Officer
8. Artist Superintendent
9. Education Officer
10. Research Officer
11. Ethnologist
12. Assistant Engineer
13. Epigraphy Assistant
14. Excavation Assistant
15. Curator

III. *Appointing authority.*—The appointing authority in respect of categories 1 to 12 shall be the Government and in respect of categories 13 to 15 shall be the Director of Archaeology.

IV. *Method of appointment.*—(a) Appointment to the categories mentioned in column (2) of the table below shall be made by the method of appointment specified against each in column (3), thereof:—

Rule 11 Savings.—Nothing contained in these rules will adversely affect those who are already in the service in accordance with the rules and orders then in force,

5. *Qualification regarding age.*—No person shall be eligible for appointment by direct recruitment, if he has not completed the age noted in column 2 or has completed the age noted in column 3 against the respective categories in column 1 in the table of this rules. On the 1st day of January of the year in which applications for appointments are invited.

Preferential: Published works in any of the fields mentioned above.

7. *Reservation of appointments.*—The rules of reservation of appointment (General Rules 14 to 17) of the Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1958 shall apply to appointments by direct recruitment.

8. *Probation.*—Any person appointed to any of the category shall, from the date on which he joins duty, be on probation,—

- (i) if appointed by direct recruitment for a total period of two years on duty, within a continuous period of three years, and
- (ii) if appointed by promotion, or by transfer for a total period of one year on duty, within a continuous period of two years.

9. *Training.*—A person appointed by direct recruitment or by transfer to any of the categories in the service shall undergo such training, as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time.

10. *Tests.*—Any person appointed to any of the categories shall, within the period of probation, pass either the Account Test for Executive Officers or the Account Test (Lower), if he has not already passed the same.

Explanatory Note

(This is not part of the Notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The Special Rules for the post of Director of Archaeology/Epigraphist and Registering Officer were issued in G. O. (P) 66/80/H.Edn. dated 9th May 1980. The Special Rules for the posts of Publication Officer, Epigraphy Assistant, Excavation Assistant and Curator were also prescribed vide G.O. (Ms.) 21/85/DD. dated 24-10-1985 and G.O. (P) 158/74/H.Edn. dated 28th October, 1974 respectively, and were subsequently amended as per G. O. (P) 209/79/H.Edn. dated 18th October, 1979. Since then the scale of pay of the posts of Epigraphist, Archaeological Chemist and Publication Officer were revised and other categories of posts were created. Besides the posts of Excavation Assistant, Epigraphy Assistant and Curator have also been included in the State service. The category of "Registering Officer" had become extinct due to abolition of the Central scheme. Thus the set up of the Department has also been considerably, changed. It has, therefore, became necessary to revise the Special Rules to incorporate the above change.
